Orléans Forest

The Orleans Forest once formed a huge wooden area which was more than 350.000 acres covering the Gâtinais and most of the Orléanais area. In the South part of the Grand Pithiverais, the largest forest of France offers 750 miles of forest paths promising enjoyable hikings, horse or bike rides, especially along GR32, and fauna observation with the osprey which came back after 3 decades and the deer whose bellows will impress you.

The valleys of Œuf, Rimarde and Essonne rivers

The Essonne river, tributary of the Seine, takes its source in the Grand Pithiverais and appears at the junction of the Œuf and the Rimarde rivers. The valleys of those 3 rivers are adapted to hiking. It is not surprising that the GR32 follows the Essonne valley. With the flow, you will discover the villages of the Grand Pithiverais, old water mills, bridges and river wash-houses related to daily life of our villages.

Gâtinais

The Gâtinais is characterized by numerous copse and hedges scattered in the agricultural space. Large farms demarcate the wooded countryside of Gâtinais with their huge dependence surrounded by pastures and old orchards. A network of paths and small roads which connect farms, hamlets and villages across plains and woods, allow hikings and promenades. The region is known for its honey, its pâté and saffron.



LA JAVELIÈRE'S GARDENS

The Javelière manor house, built in the 17th century in the middle of vines, has a garden which spreads on 10 acres. You will discover a modern rose garden surrounded by a pond, a vegetable garden and an orchard. The park contains collections of bushes and undergrowth perennials.

In a more rustic atmosphere, ancient roses, lavenders and cistus grow surrounded by rare trees. Close to it, the "Rosarium" presents an important collection of botanic roses around 300 species, coming from all around the world, especially China, America and the Middle East.

WETLAND OF MOULIN DE LA PORTE

If you are looking for a hiking, relaxing and nature discovering place, the Moulin de la Porte wetland is for you ! Inside the valley of the Œuf river, this about 50 acres of humid area offers various sides, from clear and current waters of the river to stagnant water of ponds and marshes, passing by humid meadows, reed beds and alluvial forests. This diversity of places contains an exceptional and rich flora and fauna by their variety and their heritage.

Inside the temple of nature, it is a path of discovery, guided by informative signs and Aurélien Gaudry's sculptures.

A 1 mile promenade invites you to explore different humid places and their management modes.

Born from the meeting of 3 beekeepers in 1986, the apiary school has become a place of sharing and exchange of knowledge and experience around beekeeping. Today, l'Abeille du Gâtinais is one of the most ancient apiary schools of France.

The botanical path of 1 mile long allows you to discover a huge variety of melliferous plants, a botanical garden and appreciates various types of hives which include different characteristics.

The domain of Bellecour built in 1695 and 1697 by Alphonse-Charles de Bareillier de Forteville has changed owners many times. In 1781, Pierre Lejeune, future mayor of Pithiviers, acquired it and widened it. His son, Hippolyte Lejeune, inherited it in 1812 and, at the Restoration, obtained the authorization to get the title De Bellecour in his name. From 1976 to 1984, the castle became an internship school for young girls, managed by Sisters of Saint-Dominique. The city bought the domain in December 1987, and converted it into a huge park and constructed a nice promenade, health course, picnic tables, and game structures for children.


WOODS OF JULES

For those who like to go for a walk on a shady pathway, this path offers a nice, historical and ecological promenade. This way allows you to take the bottom of the Œuf river valley, from the Ladies ford, in Dadonville, to the Bridge of Anger, in Bondaroy. You can access the river, at the wooded hillside with big trees, coppices and the Natura 2000 area, on the plateau, where rare orchids can be seen. For the most sportive ones, a health course composed of 8 apparatus is available.

ATELIER-MUSÉE DE L'IMPRIMERIE (AMI) QA5

It is the largest European museum dedicated to printing. Within a total of 6000 square meters, the AMI offers a mix of technical and industrial history - more than 150 printing machines of the 18th, 19th and 20th centuries ; cultural and literary history - more than 1000 books including the first dictionary in French, the first comic book... and press history more than 600 newspapers, most of the time number 0 or 1, of the Amsterdam newspaper at the magazine press.



Many artists, engravers, and photographs are invited to come to the new space of temporary exhibitions in the museum.

Everyone can participate in various activities (paper-making, calligraphy, marble-like, composing) thanks to all courses and workshops proposed throughout the year.

TRANSPORTS MUSEUM TOURIST RAILWAY © C3-C4

The historical railway of Pithiviers is a museum dedicated to railway narrow tracks. It takes you on a trip, in a steam or diesel train, on the old road which connected Pithiviers to Toury.

Following its commercial closing in 1964, a few volunteers have taken the Pithiviers - Toury tramway. The old wagon repair workshop has been converted into a museum.

You will discover an exceptional collection of steam locomotives classified among Historical Monuments plus a sample of materials which circulated on the historical road. The visit is enriched by old objects and pictures of this time period.

Before or after the visit of the museum, take a seat in one of the historical trains for a 2.5 miles trip between Pithiviers and line terminus of Bellebat.

For everyone's happiness, relive the extravagant time of steam trains.



PITHIVIERS TRAIN STATION

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Memorial and educational place of Shoah's history

Between 1941 and 1943, 16 000 Jews were captive in Pithiviers and Beaune-la-Rolande internment camps. Former Pithiviers' train station is one of the most emblematic places of this period where 6 convoys left to other internment camps around Paris, in particular the one in Drancy.

The terminal is restored on the occasion of the 80 years of the rafle du Vel d'Hiv commemoration in relationship with the CERCIL, which studies the former internment camp in Loiret.

The former 478sq yards station hall is now equipped with a permanent exhibition in order to explain the role of the train station of Pithiviers and Beaune-la-Rolande during the Shoah.



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CHAMEROLLES CASTLE Q E3

The castle, located in Gallerand, was built at the beginning of the Renaissance, close to Chilleurs-aux-Bois. It is the work of Lancelot du Lac 1st. Thanks to its impressive collection, you will discover the perfume, hygiene and scent story from the 16th century to nowadays. Through the perfume walk, a visual and olfactory route awaits the visitors.

The castle offers a bucolic promenade as it is surrounded by Renaissance gardens, a park and a water mirror.

ROCHEPLATTE CASTLE Q C5

The castle was built in the 11th century at the intersection of the Œuf and the Rimarde rivers in order to control the valley. The castle was burnt, sold and built again in the 18th century. CASTLE OF MALESHERBES Q A6

A fortified castle which suffered from numerous sieges during the Hundred Years' War and religious wars, the castle of Malesherbes was turned into a Renaissance castle in the 18th century (1718-1725) by Guillaume de Lamoignon, chancellor of France.

An outdoor visit of the castle (14th and 18th centuries) and the House called "de Chateaubriand" built in the 18th century. An indoor and outdoor visit to the Chapel (14th and 15th centuries), the Tithes barn (14th century) and the dovecote (18th century). The castle domain and the dependencies are classified Historical Monuments. Access only by foot, count 1 mile between the entrance grating to the castle.



CASTLE OF AMOY

From 7th century, it was a property of Saint-Denis abbey, Henry 3rd allowed, in the 16th century, Sir Jacques Hanappier, first mayor of Orleans, gentleman of Catherine of Médicis, to fortify the castle of Amoy with moats and many small pierced towers. His descent kept the castle until 1830.

MILL OF CHÂTILLON

The Mill of Châtillon, dated from the 11th century, is a rare mill of the Essonne valley which kept its wheel and all its machinery. This constitutes a remarkable ensemble. It is also a privileged witness of the flour-milling activity during the first part of the 20th century.

Property of the town since 2003, the federation of municipalities of the Pithiverais Gâtinais ensure the maintenance and the building management. As for machine renovation, volunteers from the Association de Sauvegarde et des Amis du Moulin à Eau de Châtillon (ASAMEC) endeavor to restore and renovate the wheel, the machines and ensure their maintenance. From the back of the mill, you can freely access the adjoining wetland and observe the fauna and flora of the Moulin de Châtillon marsh.
